ParentVUE: Reporting Absences

NOTES FROM ATTENDANCE

We want to partner with you to ensure that your child attends school regularly and receives the full benefit of their education. Student attendance is taken every period of the school day. To excuse your student, please submit it through ParentVUE or call our attendance line at 970-419-3401. It is really important that you give a reason for the absences. Please refer to our TMHS Handbook under attendance for what constitutes an excused absence and the details pertaining to our attendance policies. You have 5 school days to excuse your student.

Clarification of procedures for Middle School and High School students: Middle School - parents can excuse their student for pickup by calling the attendance line, submitting through ParentVUE, or by coming into the building. If a parent submits the request early in the school day, we can get a pass delivered to the student for them to show their teacher when the appropriate time to leave is. Please be aware that we need to verify who is allowed to pick up your student, and middle school students must be checked out by a parent/guardian. They may not leave campus until they are checked out by the main office. High School - Our high school students have an open campus and thus do not need to have a parent/guardian come into the building to check them out. If you have made arrangements with your student to leave for an appointment, illness, or activity, please have them communicate with their teacher. It is school policy that students are not allowed to excuse themselves, so we ask that parents/guardians call our attendance line to excuse them for the classes they are missing with the reason

Attendance:

Due to the growing number of students and increased phone calls, we have implemented a phone "tree" system to better serve our TMHS community.

When you call our main line, 419-3400, you will be prompted to the following:



The Attendance line is for reporting an absence: illness, appointments or early dismissals. This can also be done in ParentVue.

We would prefer you to call the attendance line in the morning to request an early dismissal for your student. Early release passes are distributed during the first period of the day. If your student needs to be checked out last-minute (no later than 3:45), please press 7, which is the Main Office line.

For last-minute dismissals throughout the day, please be sure to check your students' schedule as it is difficult to find students when they are on their lunch break

FALL PSAT/NMSQT INFORMATION

The PSAT/NMSQT provides students with valuable practice for the SAT while also measuring college and career readiness. Students in grade 11 are eligible to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program based on their results. While grade 10 students may also take the test for practice, they are not eligible for the scholarship program. Please note: This exam is in addition to the SAT and PSAT 10 given in the spring—not a replacement. This is not a required exam. **Please click here** for additional details about the exam, payment and registration information.

AP TESTING INFORMATION FOR FALL COURSES

Students currently enrolled in a fall AP course will have the opportunity to take the corresponding AP Exam in the spring. The cost of each exam is \$100, and students may choose which exams they would like to take. We encourage families to review the important fall AP deadlines together, as these ensure students are registered properly and on time. Our staff will also be visiting AP classes to provide reminders and support so that all students are aware of requirements. Please note: If a student is enrolled in an AP course that begins in spring 2027, they will receive exam registration details and deadlines at that time. **Please click here** for additional details about AP deadlines, exam information, and payment instructions.

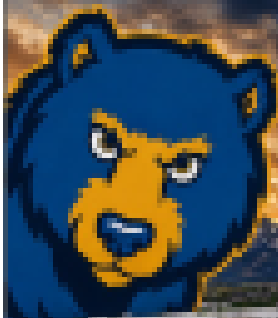

Our curbside pickup spot is on the north side of building directly behind small gym in northeast pull through (reference the image below).

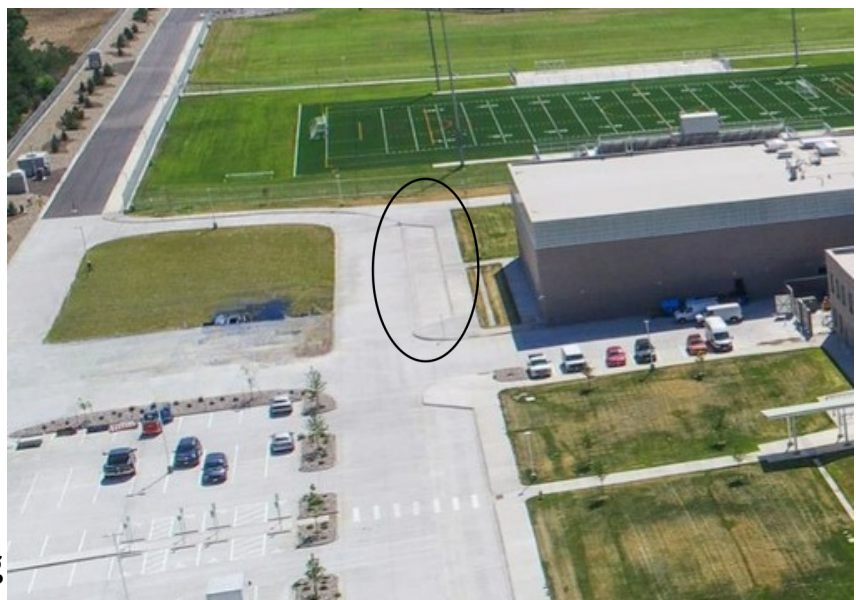

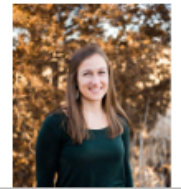
