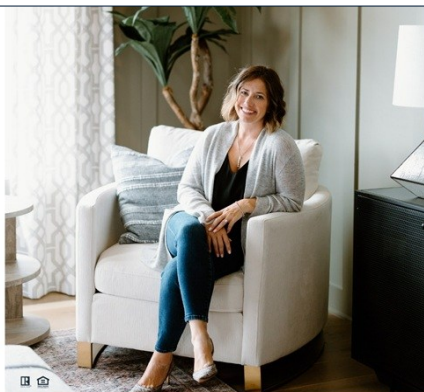

Eligibility and Submission Window

- Open to all Timnath Middle and High students (6th-12th)
- Entries must be received between April 6 and April 17, 2026.
- All submissions must be turned in no later than 4:05 p.m. on April 17, 2026.

Entry Guidelines

- Poets may submit up to two poems.
- Each poem must be 40 lines or fewer.
- Poems must be unpublished and consist of completely original content.
 - Use of AI-generated content (including ChatGPT) is *not permitted*.

Submission Process

An electronic copy must be emailed to vstrawn@psdschools.org with "poetry contest" in the subject line.

Please include your name, student ID number, and grade. Students are encouraged to carefully proofread their poems for spelling, grammar, and content accuracy before submission.

Language Requirements

- Poems may be written in any language.
- If a poem is not written in English, a complete English translation must also be submitted.
- Students who need assistance with translation should notify Ms. Strawn when submitting their poem to the Media Center.

Judging

- Poems will be judged by Middle and High School Language Arts Teachers
- Judging will occur between April 20 and April 23, 2026.
- Judging decisions are final.

- Winners will be announced on Monday, April 27, 2026, via:
 - Morning announcements
 - A phone call to families
 - A written invitation to attend the poetry reading and breakfast

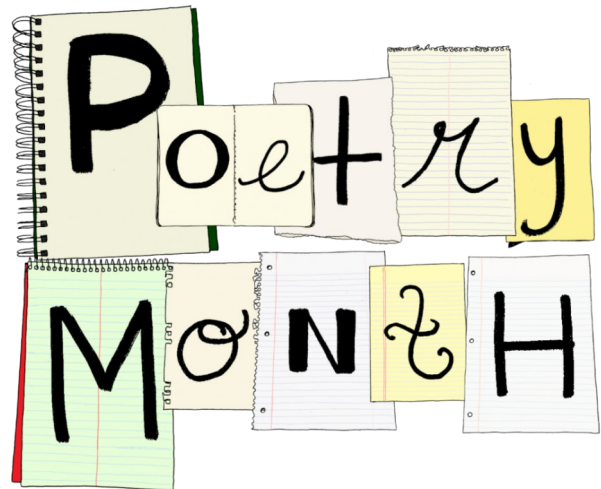

Winter Sports Season Recap

As we wrap up an exciting winter sports season, we want to take a moment to celebrate the incredible accomplishments, perseverance, and school spirit shown by our Timnath Cubs athletes, coaches, and community.

Boys' Basketball

What a remarkable run for our boys' basketball team! The Cubs advanced all the way to the Final Four, highlighted by an unforgettable playoff journey.

After hosting and winning the 4A Regional Tournament, the team battled through intense matchups, including a thrilling double-overtime victory over Eagle Ridge Academy—sealed by clutch free throws from Max Roselle with just 1.4 seconds remaining.

The team carried that momentum into the Great 8 and then the Final Four at the Denver Coliseum, where they earned a hard-fought win over Lamar to advance. They ultimately fell in a close, emotional game to Kent Denver, but their grit, teamwork, and determination never wavered.

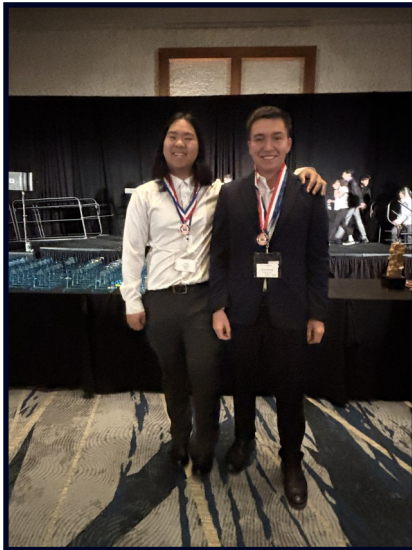
