




# **ATTENDANCE**

# The McKinney-Vento program

supports students and families in a variety of living situations including:

- Sharing housing with friends or relatives due to loss of housing or economic need
- · Living in motels, RVs, or camp grounds
- · Shelters or transitional housing
- Living in cars, parks, public spaces, or abandoned buildings
- · Substandard housing, i.e. mold, infestations, or without utilities





# **Housing Instability in Our Community**

- The McKinney-Vento program supports students and families experiencing housing instability or homelessness by helping them access resources, meet basic needs, and overcome barriers to education.
- At the end of the 2024-25 school vear, 1,429 students in PSD were enrolled in the McKinney-Vento
- This represents almost 5% of our entire student population
- This number has increased by 18% in the last 6 years
