Students will need to turn in their **ASSIGNED** laptop and charger during this event to avoid any lost technology fees. This will take place during school hours. We need your assistance to remind your student(s) to double check with the Tech team and make sure they have their assigned tech items. The tech team will be rescanning all technology, to make sure all items are properly checked in before communication is sent out to families, regarding lost technology fees.

We greatly appreciate your help and support! Go Cubs!!

FAQs

- **What if my student needs a laptop & charger for the Summer?**
 - Whether it's for Summer school or other needs, please have your student talk to the TMH Tech Team in the Media Center OR their counselor. This will help us to identify your student's need, how we can support them, and not charge them any technology fee.
- **What happens if my student doesn't turn in their assigned technology?**
 - After the final scanning is complete, the TMH Tech Team pulls finalizes inventory and sends the data to District IT and Finance. If technology items OR technology fees are not paid, student(s) will NOT get a laptop and charger checked out to them during registration event next school year.
- **What are the lost fees for technology?**
 - * Please refer to the [TMHS Technology Acknowledgement](#)
- **For the 2025-2026 school year, lost fees are the following:**
 - Charger: \$27
 - Laptops: \$460
- **Why is assigned technology important?**
 - Both the laptop and charger are specifically checked out to individual students during the school year. This helps IF tech is turned in, who is using it, etc. Even if students turn in tech items that are NOT assigned to them, they will still be charged the lost tech fee(s). This is why it's very important to have students check in with the tech team during the school year. This may also result in not receiving a laptop/charger during registration for the following school year.

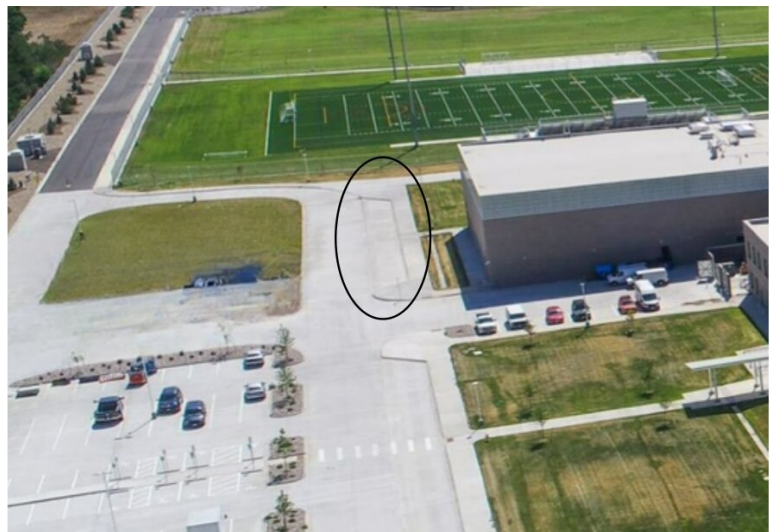
