




### **ATTENDANCE**

\* The Attendance line is for reporting an absence: illness, appointments or early dismissals. This can also be done in ParentVue.



  - a. 3.0+ unweighted GPA, have SAT scores of higher than 490+ on both Math and Reading/Writing, and have to demonstrate financial needs.







- This October, Middle School counselors will be going into all 6th grade social studies classrooms to discuss with students the importance of creating a strong community at Timnath.     - What can we do to make it right? What do we need to do moving forward?


